

Considered one of the most talented guitarists of his generation, former child prodigy and multi-award winner guitarist Daniel Murray (www.danielmurray.com.br) is extremely active as an interpreter, an arranger and a composer. He performs as a soloist or in chamber ensembles touring extensively Brazil and abroad with musicians like Paulo Bellinati, Israel de Almeida, Toninho Carrasqueira, among many other renowned Brazilian guitarists and musicians. At the age of 15, he won the "Councours International de Guitarre of Trédrez-Locquémeau" in Brittany that led to a successful French tour. Since 2009, he has been touring with the "Quarteto Tau" and has formed the Saraiva-Murray Duo performing several concerts in Europe (Paris, London, Portugal, Greece, etc). The year 2011 sees him on tour around the country with grants from ProAc to support his second solo album, "Tom Jobim para violão solo" (Delira Música) and has since toured with the electro-acoustic ensemble "Universos Trio".

Presented as "The new voice of the Clarinet" on the front page of "De Klarinet" magazine, internationally recognized for his groundbreaking contributions to contemporary clarinet music, Luca Luciano (www.lucaluciano.com) starts his career at the young age of twelve debuting at one of the most established halls of his home town Naples. He graduated from the Conservatoire of Salerno (Italy) and, according to the Clarinet & Saxophone Society of Great Britain, he has since "established himself as the friendly face of contemporary clarinet". Described by the BBC Radio as "one of Europe's leading exponent of jazz clarinet", Luca's repertoire also embraces Brahms, Stravinsky, Poulenc, Berio. Luciano has held many master-classes, has premiered his music at St Martin in the Fields and has performed at the South Bank Centre (also recording live for BBC Radio 3 at the Royal Festival Hall), Edinburgh Festival, Cambridge University. As a recording artist, Luca's solo albums have received much critical acclaim in three continents.
